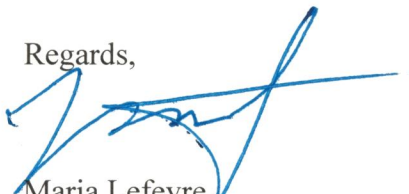
This letter provides notice that the U.S. Department of Transportation (Department or DOT) is withdrawing selection of your Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Program grant selection, Campo Road Revitalization Demonstration Project, announced on November 15, 2024.

DOT's priorities presently include:

- ensuring that taxpayer dollars are used efficiently in ways that maximally benefit the American people and improve their quality of life
- reducing roadway traffic congestion by preserving or increasing roadway capacity for motor vehicles

Having individually reviewed your project in light of DOT's priorities, the Department has determined that your grant selection is inconsistent with the priorities listed above. Specifically, your project seeks to demonstrate bike lane striping that appears to reduce lane capacity and a road diet that is hostile to motor vehicles, which runs counter to DOT's priority of preserving or increasing roadway capacity for motor vehicles. Because your project is no longer in accordance with agency priorities, the Department is withdrawing the selection of your project for an SS4A grant.
