A MESSAGE FROM DEANNA MACKEY

On July 18, Congress approved the elimination of all federal funding to the public broadcasting system. We have been preparing for this moment, both financially and mentally. While a loss of nearly \$4.3 million annually is significant, financial scenario planning is the easier of the two. Trying to prepare for the emotions of arriving at this point takes a herculean effort. There is no denying this is a very sad moment. We are watching colleagues make difficult decisions, including the Corporation for Public Broadcasting announcing it will shut down by September 30.

While this is a challenging time, KPBS is not going anywhere. This moment in history will not unravel what we have spent 65 years building - an essential public service for San Diego. We are fortunate to be heading into this new chapter from a place of financial stability because of your support. Now we need your additional help to keep us going strong into the coming years ahead as we face this multi-million dollar funding gap.
