

**SAN DIEGO-CARLSBAD-SAN MARCOS METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA
(SAN DIEGO COUNTY)**

Nonfarm employment up by 600 jobs over the month and up 23,200 jobs over the year

The unemployment rate in the San Diego County was 6.4 percent in December 2013, down from a revised 6.9 percent in November 2013, and below the year-ago estimate of 8.2 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 7.9 percent for California and 6.5 percent for the nation during the same period.

Between November 2013 and December 2013, total nonfarm employment increased from 1,302,400 to 1,303,000, a gain of 600 jobs. Agricultural employment declined by 600 jobs, or 6.4 percent.

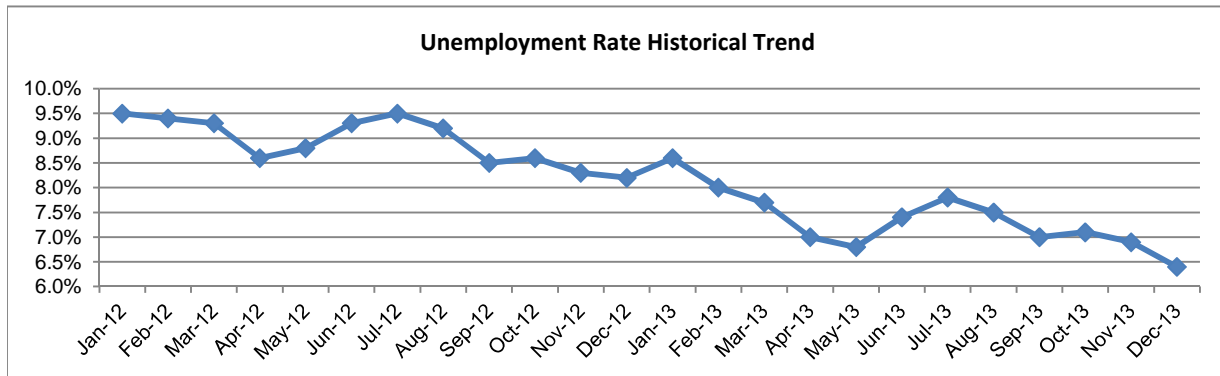
- Educational and health services posted the greatest month-over change, adding 1,600 jobs. Health care and social assistance (up 1,600) accounted for all of the gain, mostly from ambulatory health care services (up 1,100).
- Three other sectors also added jobs over the month: trade, transportation, and utilities (up 1,300); construction (up 500); and manufacturing (up 100).
- Five other nonfarm industries recorded month-over job losses. The most notable came from professional and business services (down 800); other services (down 800); leisure and hospitality (down 600); and government (down 600).

Between December 2012 and December 2013, total nonfarm employment increased by 23,200 jobs, or 1.8 percent. Agricultural employment gained 100 jobs, or 1.1 percent.

- Educational and health services reported the greatest year-over change, adding 6,200 jobs. Health care and social assistance (up 4,500) accounted for more than 70 percent of the job growth in this sector, primarily from ambulatory health care services (up 3,200). Educational services increased by 1,700 jobs.
- Six other nonfarm sectors also posted year-over job growth. The most significant gains came from construction (up 5,700); leisure and hospitality (up 5,600); and trade, transportation, and utilities (up 5,300).
- Two industries recorded job losses over the year: manufacturing (down 1,600) and information (down 500).
