

Director's Notes




Jennie Gray Connard, Director of Avenue Q

My love for The Muppets started at a very early age. I remember later in my young life, some kids not wanting to admit that they liked Sesame Street but what wasn't to like? Super Grover was HILARIOUS and kind, Big Bird had a reclusive "imaginary" friend with beautiful evelashes. Cookie Monster loved my favorite food and Luis & Gordon were very handsome. I would come home from pre-school and then Kindergarten on the back of my Mom's bicycle, eat my Spaghettio's and watch my favorite show. It made me happy, it taught me things and it ENTERTAINED me. (Don't judge my Mom, it was the 70s, of course I was eating Spaghettio's). Just a few short years later The Muppet Show began. I was overjoyed! 
